2 goals of meeting:

- review of draft plan
- move forward on a consensus for the name of the park

Presentation of Draft Park Plan

Discussion on why a neighborhood center is not shown on plan:

- Not feasible for the County to operate
- no funds to staff and operate over the long run
- long-term building maintenance is difficult to fund
- building would need additional parking that would take away from the park

Discussion on the Draft Park Plan:

Group 1

- need restroom on large parcel
- make court full size for other sports - volleyball, tennis, etc.
- remove skate park for cost cut
- shade structure in picnic area
- multi-use sports field

Group 2

- community garden or dog park could be left off plan (dogs can use rest of park)
- shade structure needed
- what will happen to existing roses and mini-library?
- using existing fence for mural art - remove trees
- need for color and art
- mural locations needed
- baseball diamond

Group 3 (youth)

- club for kids after school
- too many trees - remove some
- art projects on fence
- white roses in memorial area
- swings and slide in playground
- multi-purpose field

- need security for safe park

Group 4

- more color - fruit and flowering plants
- benches needed in dog park
- storage for programs (perhaps incorporate into restroom building)
- oak tree planted for Andy – preserve and incorporate into memorial design
- kiosko could happen later
- reduce parking for cost savings – remove parking from small parcel

Open comments:

- lighting?
- drinking fountains?
- preserve existing roses in memorial area (white Honor roses - Andy's favorite color)
- consider transplanting existing roses into new design
- would like to see costs for each item

Discussion of Park Name:

- task is to find a name that has broad acceptance and bring people together:

Results from small group discussions (4 groups):

1. Andy's Honor Park / Andy's Neighborhood Park
 - to honor Andy and the neighborhood
2. Andy Lopez Park - A Celebration of Life
 - should be full name of Andy Lopez to remember the tragedy that happened here
 - park is a political process
 - the tragedy was the catalyst for the park
 - Moorland is not a positive association - swamp
3. Andy's Neighborhood Park
 - Focus on neighborhood and remembering Andy
4. Andy's Peace Park
 - Rest in peace Andy


