



TOLAY LAKE REGIONAL PARK LIVESTOCK NOTICE

- Leave gates as you found them (open or closed)
 - Cattle may act in a defensive manner in response to a perceived threat to their safety.
 - Don't attempt to touch or pet cows, calves, or other animals. Don't get between a calf and its mother.
 - Dogs are perceived as predators. Dogs are required to be on leash at all times. Don't allow your dog to harass cattle.
 - Try not to startle cattle. Keep your distance when possible.
 - Give cattle plenty of space and a clear exit.
 - If cattle are on the trail ahead of you, they will normally disperse if you wave your arms and shout well in advance. If they do not disperse, your other option is to turn around and go back.
 - Report cattle that are threatening, sick or dead. Please note the location, color of the animal, and ear tag number if possible.
